

SYCAMORE TOWNSHIP
UNPLAYABLE FIELDS GUIDELINES

Township fields/pitches/ball fields will be considered unplayable if any of the following conditions exist:

1. Standing water on the field/pitch/ball field.
2. Water sponging up around one's feet when walking on the grass on the field.
3. Weather conditions – lightning, thunderstorms.

If any of these conditions occur, the field/pitch/ball field will be considered “UNPLAYABLE” and the practice/game will be cancelled.

If a group arrives at the field and these conditions exist or if these conditions develop during a game or practice, it is not permitted to play on the field/pitch/ball field. Factors to be considered include:

- Safety of the participants
- Possibility of liability through accident or injury
- Expense of field/pitch/ball field repair and maintenance

If a group ignores the “Unplayable” conditions:

*Permit holder will be required to pay for all damages arising from abuse of the facilities.

*Permit holder could be held liable and responsible for accidents or injuries incurred because of unsafe conditions.

*Permit holder will have permit revoked.

Fields/ pitches/ ball fields will not be used if lightning is visible.
